Scout Code of Conduct



- I will follow the SCOUT LAW, SCOUT OATH and the OUTDOOR CODE. I will remember these are the basis for all the following rules and should be the basis for all my actions.
- I am expected to follow the posted or verbal schedule of activities and assignments specified by the troop leadership.
- I am expected to be on time for all troop events or let leadership know beforehand.
- I may not possess any alcoholic beverages, tobacco, or illegal drugs. If found, my parents will be notified immediately and possibly the police.
- When on troop outings, I understand unless otherwise instructed, lights will be out, and I will be in bed by 11pm. I will be quiet to allow others to sleep.
- No visitors will be allowed in other people's tents without permission from an adult leader.
- Sounds that can be heard outside my tent after lights out are disrespectful and disturbing to others. Lack of compliance will be dealt with by troop leaders.
- If I damage any property owned by a camp I am visiting, the troop, or another individual, I will be responsible for replacement or reimbursement of the item.
- The use of profanity or abusive language will not be tolerated. I understand I may be fined \$1, per occurrence, if I am found in violation.
- I will not bring any electronic devices like phones, computers, tablets, dvd players, radios to any troop events (unless approved beforehand by an Adult leader).
- I will use matches and lighters only when appropriate and after I have earned my Fireman's Chit.
- I will only use knives, saws and axes only when appropriate and after I have earned my Toten Chip.
- I will use the "Buddy System" on all scouting activities.
- Our troop is primarily responsible for the behavior, safety and welfare of our members on all camping events. At district of council events, as well as at BSA camps, all camp staff have the right and responsibility to help and correct any problems they encounter. I will follow the directions of those leaders as if they were the troop's leaders.
- If I have been disciplined for similar behavior more than three times, Scoutmasters have the ability to suspend me from the troop indefinitely based on their discretion.
